



What is **NEO**?

NEO is an initiative aiming to improve workforce quality and the employability of poor and vulnerable youth in Latin America and the Caribbean.

It is a pioneering alliance in which businesses, governments, and civil society join forces to provide resources, knowledge, and capacities in order to implement effective and sustainable youth employment solutions.



NEO regional objectives for the next 5 years are

Strengthen the capacity of 200 job service providers.

Prepare 500,000 poor and vulnerable youth, ages 16-29 for the labor market and ensure that 50% or more of the youth trained are young women.

Mobilize 1,000 companies to offer internships and employment opportunities for youth


Achieve job placement rates of 50% for program graduates.

Alliance

Establish and strengthen multistakeholder partnerships at the country level in order to design, share and implement common youth employability strategies and financing plans.

Knowledge

Evaluate the quality of job service providers based on NEO's quality standards, and strengthen organizations through the transfer and adaptation of systematized best practices for life skills training, career counseling and intermediation, validated for public and private service providers.
